## ON TUESDAY the Church celebrates the **The Birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary, our Patron Saint**

This festival in honour of the birth of the mother of our Lord is celebrated in both the Eastern and Western Churches. Falling just nine months after the Feast of the Conception of Mary, the feast stands on the boundary between the old and the new covenants, and ushers in the dispensation of grace. Today, with the birth of Mary, 'a shrine is built for the creator of the universe'.

## NEXT SUNDAY the Church celebrates the life of **John Chrysostom Bishop of Constantinople, Teacher of the Faith, 407**

John was born in Antioch, the third city of the Roman Empire, in about 347. He was a brilliant preacher which earned him in the sixth century the surname 'Chrysostom', literally 'golden-mouthed'. He is honoured as one of the four Greek Doctors of the Church. Against his wish he was made Patriarch of Constantinople in 398. He set about reforming the Church and exposing corruption amongst the clergy and in the imperial administration. 'Mules bear fortunes and Christ dies of hunger at your gate,' he is alleged to have cried out. He fell foul of the Empress Eudoxia, and in spite of the support of Pope Innocent 1 of Rome, was sent into exile twice, finally dying of exhaustion and starvation in September 407, with the words 'Glory be to God for everything' on his lips.
